### FACTS WHAT DOES Post Lake Lending DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Why? Financial companies choose how they share Your personal information. Consumers have the right to limit some but not all sharing. They also have the right to know how We collect, share, and protect Your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what We do.

What? The types of personal information We collect and share depend on the product or service You have with Us. This information can include:

- \*Social Security number and checking account information
- \*Payment history and income
- \*Employment information and wire transfer instructions

How? All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, We list the financial companies can share their customers personal information; the reason Post Lake Lending chooses to share; and whether You can limit our sharing.

### Who we are

Who is providing this notice? Post Lake Lending, an economic arm and instrumentality of a Native American Indian Tribe.

### What we do

How does Post Lake Lending protect my personal information? To protect Your personal information from unauthorized access and use, We use security measures. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.

How does Post Lake Lending collect my personal information? We collect your personal information, for example, when you

- \*Apply for a loan
- \*Give us your income information
- \*Tell us where to send the money
- \*Provide account information
- \*Provide employment information

We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates or other financial companies.

Why can't I limit all sharing? Under applicable law, You have the right to limit only:

- \*sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes – information about your creditworthiness
- \*affiliates from using your information to market to you
- \*sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you

What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else? Your choices will apply to everyone on your account.

### Definitions

Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.  <i>*Our affiliates include other business entities of the Tribe.</i>
Non-affiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. Nonaffiliates we share information with include service providers and data processors.
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. Post Lake Lending does not jointly market.
